General Presbyter, John Odom, Receives New Call

By letter received late last week, John Odom, General Presbyter of the Mid-Ky Presbytery, informed SFPC and the other churches in the Mid-Ky Presbytery that the Presbytery of Genesee Valley voted to approve his call as its new Executive Presbyter. He has asked the Mid-Kentucky Presbytery to receive his letter of resignation effective Tuesday, September 17, 2024, so that he can begin his new ministry in Rochester, NY, effective October 14, 2024.

Rev. Odom's letter, a portion of which is quoted below, reflects his appreciation of the Mid-Ky Presbytery, and his passion for serving the Lord.

"Dear Mid-Ky Presbytery, Nine years ago, the Spirit of God moved powerfully in my life. It led me into conversation with the presbyter for Community Life search committee. From that very first encounter, I have felt God's hand guiding and Christ's voice calling me to this awesome and fulfilling position in leadership of Mid-Kentucky Presbytery.

In countless ways, great and small, that initial calling to be your presbyter for Community Life, turned general presbyter, has been confirmed. We have laughed together, cried together, fought together, praised God together, grown together. Most importantly, I know that we have been transformed by Christ's love and the love for one another, together. Christ has blessed us, and we have become a blessing to each other, our communities and our world. Together we have advanced our common vision of developing strong spiritual leaders who empower lifegiving congregations for the transformation of the world by faith in God though Jesus Christ.

Over twelve months ago, I began to feel the stirring of the Spirit in my life again. It was a stirring not out of any sense of disaffection with Mid-Kentucky Presbytery, but was a desire to continue my vocational growth. I want to use my mid council leadership skills to develop, demonstrate and deploy teaching and ruling elders and congregations with the transformational love of Christ in a new presbytery ministry context. I have prayed for guidance. I have tested the spirits. I have thrown all the pieces of my life up in the air and asked God to help to sort them out. I am convinced that God has seen me through this discernment process.

With fear and trembling, reverence and wonder, I am ready to make another leap of faith as I follow Christ's call. On Tuesday evening, July 30, 2024, the Presbytery of Genesee Valley voted to approved my call as their executive presbyter. It will be my responsibility to provide networking, leadership support, pastoral care and administrative oversight for the 55 congregations and new worshipping communities in the Rochester, NY, area. I will be asked to institute a new presbytery structure and help further a plan which may, in time, see the merger of Genesee Valley and Geneva presbyteries. Genesee Valley Presbytery, like Mid-Kentucky Presbytery, has many of the same passions and priorities for serving Christ, and it is the place where I feel my gifts and abilities best meet the legitimate needs of Christ's church."

Rev. Odom has provided outstanding and energetic leadership to SFPC in many ways, including leading us in worship, serving as the Session Moderator and providing training for the church officers. Please remember him in your prayers and ask the Lord to bless him in his travels and in his new position.


