Presbyterians owe a great deal of gratitude to the presbytery's Personnel Committee – Chair Betty Muse (Trinity), Chuck Hance (Hopewell), Angela Johnson (Grace-Hope), Candi Cubbage (HR), and Angie Andriot (Highland). This committee has been working tirelessly on your behalf to find the best Interim General Presbyter out there.

In the next few days their work SHOULD come to fruition. The best candidate has been identified from an initial field of at least 10 candidates. Multiple interviews have been conducted. Later this week the Personnel Committee will meet with their chosen candidate to finalize terms of call.

Because in the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) everything takes a village, there will be a flurry of other meetings in coming days to complete the process:

The candidate will be introduced to the Coordinating Commission (but NOT approved by the commission – hiring authority resides with the Personnel Committee) – for conversation and feedback by the commission on the selection.

The terms of call will have to be approved by the Commission on Ministry.

The financial terms of the call will be reviewed by the Finance Committee.

Once all of those steps have been completed – hopefully by the end of this weekend, the chosen candidate is prepared to begin work full-time as Interim General Presbyter on October 1, 2024. The Coordinating Commission will determine the best way to introduce the Interim General Presbyter to the entire presbytery.

This has been extraordinary work by a highly-skilled Personnel Committee, working in collaboration with other committees and commissions of the presbytery and the staff.

Once again the extraordinary leadership we are blessed with in this presbytery has served us well. So when you see any of the Personnel Committee members out and about, thank them for the incredible amount of time and talent they have put into this search.
