Summer of Learning for Every Generation at South Frankfort Presbyterian Church

This summer, South Frankfort Presbyterian Church was blessed to offer unique experiences for adults, teens and children to grow in their faith.

In early June, members of our congregation gathered for Adult Bible School, exploring the theme, "What God Has to Say to Us in the 21st Century." Each evening began with a light supper and fellowship before participants engaged in thoughtful Bible study and discussion on topics Christians encounter in today's world. Sessions explored how to read Scripture for guidance in daily life, the Church's role in public policy, biblical perspectives on sexual ethics, and reproductive ethics. These evenings encouraged participants to study God's Word faithfully while considering how it speaks into the challenges of modern life.

The following week, our Senior High youth attended the Montreat Youth Conference in Montreat, North Carolina.. Centered around the theme "Wonder and Wander". Students joined other youth from across the country for a week of worship, Bible study, recreation, and community-building in the mountains. Throughout the week, they were invited to reflect on what it means to follow Christ with curiosity, courage, and openness to where God is leading. Time spent in large-group worship, small-group conversations, and shared experiences helped deepen their faith and strengthen friendships within the group. They returned home encouraged, energized, and challenged to continue walking with Christ in their everyday lives, bringing home stories, insights, and a renewed sense of wonder at God's presence in the world.

To end the month, our church came alive with the sounds of laughter, music, and excited voices as children embarked on our River of Life Vacation Bible School. Throughout the week, children discovered three foundational truths through Bible stories, crafts, games, music, and special guest speakers; God Provides, God Protects, and God Loves.

One of the week's highlights was welcoming representatives from Hope for Tomorrow in Guatemala, who shared how our faith calls us to care for God's creation and our neighbors around the world.

The week concluded with a memorable River Boat Tour and fellowship at the Ward Oates Amphitheater. As we celebrated all that God had done throughout the week, He even blessed us with a refreshing summer rain. While it left us a little wetter than planned, it became a fitting reminder of the "living water" that flows from Christ and a joyful ending to an unforgettable week.

Together these events reflected our church's commitment to lifelong Christian education and discipleship. Participants of every age were reminded that God continues to guide, provide, protect, and love His people.

These ministries would not have been possible without the many volunteers who planned lessons, prepared meals, decorated classrooms, led music, organized activities, welcomed families, and faithfully served behind the scenes. Your generosity of time, talent, and love for Christ made these weeks a tremendous success.

Thank you to everyone who participated, prayed, donated, and served so we could all grow in our understanding of God's love. We look forward to seeing how God continues to use these experiences to strengthen our congregation and our community.

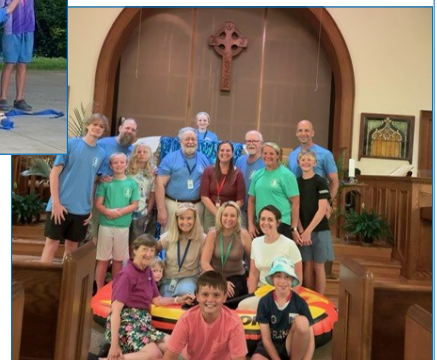

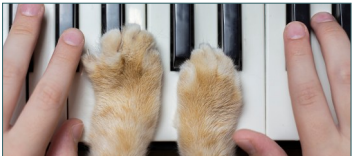
