Ordinary Time

Summer is beginning to wind down. Margaret and I have completed the rounds of visiting our children at their faraway homes. Vacations are ending. School is about to begin. Labor Day is around the corner. We are in ordinary time.

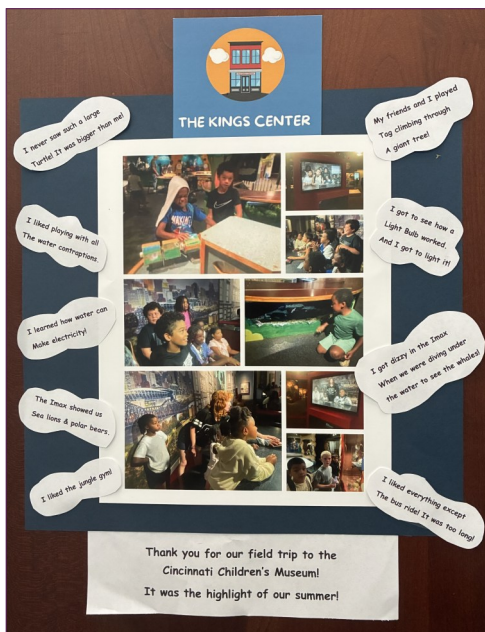
What is ordinary time? For Presbyterians, ordinary time involves “decent and ordered rhythm” that recognizes the “in-between time.” Ordinary time recognizes that most days are not lived at the peaks, but rather in the mundane, the regular, the, well, ordinary. To live healthy lives, we need to learn to treasure life during ordinary time.

Ordinary time is recognized by the PC(USA) as a primary period of mission and action. One event coming up in which our church will be participating is the World Communion Offering. This offering runs from September 6 through October 4, with the main celebration taking place on World Communion Sunday on October 4. This will be one opportunity to answer the question posed in Micah 6:8: “What does the Lord require of you, but to do justice, and to walk humbly with your God.” How will the World Communion Offering contribute to doing justice? These gifts will be used to advance racial justice, gender justice, peacemaking, global witness, and ecumenical and interfaith relations.

Envelopes will be placed in bulletins during the week or two proceeding World Communion Sunday.

We are in ordinary time. Make the best of it by doing justice and walking humbly with your God.

The class meets for about 45” from 10 a.m. in a classroom in the basement of the Education building.

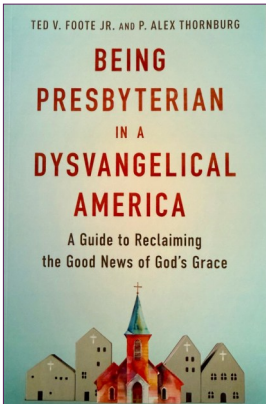
You are invited to come and try the class and discuss the class.

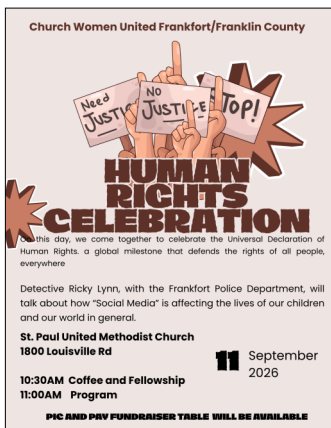
Only 45 More to Reach Our Goal of 500
